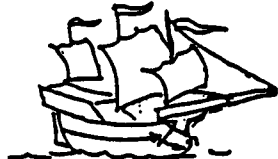

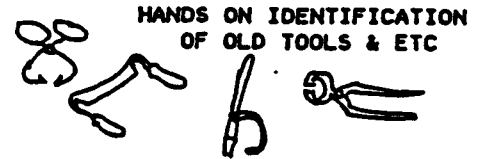
THE SEAMAN AND HIS
